
**The Express Rail Link - Temporary Demolition of the Footbridges at Sham Mong Road (Hoi Lai Shopping Centre) and Sham Shing Road**

To facilitate the construction of the Express Rail Link at Sham Mong Road, the existing footbridges at Sham Mong Road (connecting to Hoi Lai Shopping Centre) and Sham Shing Road will be closed for demolition from **December 2010**. Meanwhile, the northbound and southbound slow lanes of that section of Sham Mong Road, the eastbound and westbound slow lanes of that section of Sham Shing Road, together with part of the associated footpath will be temporarily closed for about two years.

During the closure period, a temporary re-provision footbridge across Sham Mong Road and a temporary at-grade pedestrian crossing across Sham Shing Road will be constructed for public use. As the lift at the junction of Sham Shing Road and Sham Mong Road (near Sham Shui Po Government Primary School) will be suspended from service during the period December 2010 to December 2011 for about 1 year, pedestrians could use the existing at-grade pedestrian crossing in front of Block 6 of Aqua Marine for crossing Sham Mong Road. When the footbridge lift is reopened, pedestrians can use the temporary footbridge in connection with Hoi Lai Shopping Centre to cross Sham Mong Road. We herewith attached a diversion route map for your kind information and this map will be posted at appropriate locations until the completion of the works.

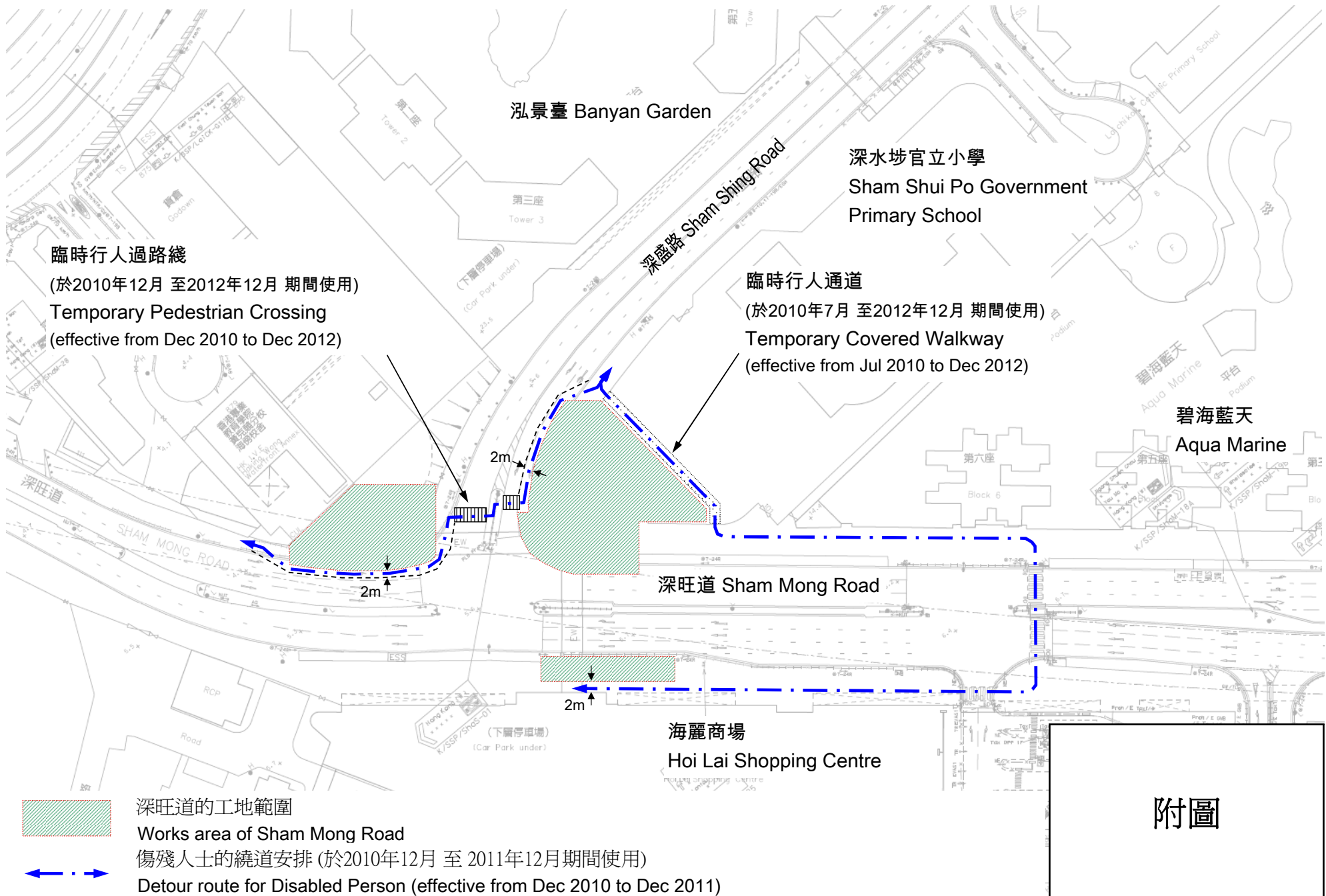
