Hoarding design competition to promote the XRL Project to the local community

The Hoarding Design Competition of the XRL project for Kwai Tsing had been successfully held with an overwhelming 370 plus submissions from students in more than 30 schools in the district.

An award ceremony was held on 22 January to present awards to the winners. All the winning entries will be displayed along the hoarding of the XRL work sites in the district for the public's enjoyment.

Blasting works at Wing Yip Street \ Tai Lin Pai Road commenced

Blasting works at Wing Yip Street and Tai Lin Pai Road started in February for constructing the XRL tunnels. Advanced notices were arranged to alert residents nearby about the blasting arrangement. Adequate mitigation measures were also imposed to minimise impact to nearby residence. These included displaying blasting schedules at the work site, setting up of traffic signs to alert road users, showing blasting signs, and arranging workers to alert the public with gongs before proceeding blasting works.

Explosives and detonators used in blasting are stored separately, while enclosures and flame-proof curtains would be in place to ensure safety during blasting.
