Stage I of ground treatment works and related temporary traffic management scheme at Hoi Wan Road

Due to the possible impact to the nearby community and road closures, the tunnel boring method will be used along Hoi Wang Road. After a detailed ground investigation, ground treatment works (commonly known as 'grouting') would be required to prepare for the tunnel construction by 2012.

Ground treatment works, the common preparatory work for tunnel construction, involves injecting pressurised cement grout from the ground level through vertical holes underground to consolidate the stratum. In general, the ground treatment locations are determined after the detailed ground investigation work has been completed.

Phase I of the temporary traffic management scheme (TTMS) is being carried out from April until the first quarter of 2012.

Preparatory works at Sham Mong Road progressing well

Preparatory works in the Tai Kok Tsui area are progressing well with the demolition of the footbridge at the junction of Sham Mong Road and Hoi Fai Road.
